

Waste of Electrical and Electronic Equipment

With production increases in electrical and electronic equipment throughout the world, there has been a significant increase in waste of these products, known within the EU as WEEE. In recognition of environmental impact, the European Parliament ratified the WEEE Directive¹ to reduce landfill waste arising from electrical and electronic equipment and to improve the environmental performance of all those involved in the life cycle of these products, as well as increasing the reuse of products. The Directive has been implemented into the national laws of the 27 European Union Member States and applies to businesses that manufacture, import, and recycle such equipment.

ArcSight and the WEEE Directive

ArcSight is committed to meeting the requirements of the EU WEEE Directive and national laws where ArcSight is considered to be the legal producer. Accordingly, ArcSight will finance the collection, treatment, and recycling of applicable products placed on the market after the 13th of August 2005.

All ArcSight electrical and electronic equipment is labeled with the crossed-out "wheelie-bin" symbol indicating that such products are to be separated from municipal waste at end-of-life.

WEEE Product Collection and Recycling

While ArcSight is not considered the WEEE producer in many European countries, ArcSight does offer collection and treatment for its products in all EU countries. Upon request, ArcSight will arrange for collection at one of its designated drop off locations, providing treatment and recycling to its customers. Under certain circumstances ArcSight will also take back other manufacturers' equipment when such equipment is displaced by new ArcSight products, on a one-for-one basis. Once WEEE has been collected, ArcSight's aim is to utilize only the most efficient and effective treatment and recycling technologies, including recovery of as much reusable materials as possible with any residual waste disposal done in an environmentally friendly manner.
